In partnership with Black Scholars and Professionals, Inter Varsity USA and Logos Hope, we were able to raise awareness by having students share on the topic. On Friday, 13 June 2025, over one hundred people gathered on the Logos Hope Ship to help break the silence and discuss how the gospel can be effective in addressing these issues.

Panellists Caleb Harry, Orisia Robinson, Leesa Robinson, Dellonte Boucher, and Aaron McDonald shared their thoughts on the topics of Abuse in Homes, Schools, Churches, Social Media, and Social Organisations. These panellists spent time preparing to share where we are as a society in respect to the treatment of our youth and the way forward.

Passionate in their delivery, the students shared the heart of God for the youth through His Word and the responsibility of the general public to protect our young people from the cycles of abuse that have plagued generations.

Trained Counsellors and Social Workers were also at the event to help guide the discussion and offer more insight into the issues. A lot was said but time was a limiting factor as persons wanted the opportunity to share their experiences and encourage the students in attendance. We sincerely thank our partners and attendees for making the event a successful one and we pray that God will grant us the strategies and the open door to have conversations and deal with the issues that are affecting our students.

A call to go the extra mile

In the third term of the 2024-2025 academic year, the Dr JP Eustace Memorial Secondary School had no formal club meetings. Sponsor, Mrs Altidore felt God's voice instructing her to meet students individually and mentor them. An instruction that she was hesitant at first to obey, but felt she could not ignore any longer. She looked for the support of other teachers to keep formal meetings active, but was unsuccessful in doing so. Yet, she felt she had to be obedient.

The first student Mrs Altidore met and engaged in conversation with was a student who had been silently praying that God would send someone her way to teach her about God. Mrs Altidore was her answered prayer.

Every week, they met for a time of scripture engagement and it was in one of those sessions that the student surrendered her heart to the Lord. She answered her questions and provided resources to help the student grow in the knowledge of Christ.

Additionally, she encouraged her to find assistance at a local church where she can have community and be baptized. Today this student is a part of the ISCCF Club and is making Christ known to her peers.
